

FROM THE PASTOR


I have a friend who has a hectic life. He has 4 young children; he and his wife both work full-time; and he always walks around like he is two paces behind where he should be. One year, he told me that he, with his family, decided that they would keep an empty drawer in the kitchen. This is usually that drawer, you know, the one where all the random stuff goes. For my friend and his family, having an empty drawer was a metaphor for living simply, for keeping clear of things that are extra and aren't needed in one's life. And that extra space reminded them symbolically that there is always space in one's busy life for God.

We use every drawer in our kitchen, but I still like my friend's metaphor and think about it years after he told me about it. As the new year unfolds for us, and our schedules start to fill again, may we always keep a clear space in our lives for peace, for simplicity, and for God.

As the year begins at Presbyterian Church in Leonia, I hope the ways you find to engage around here are life-giving. I hope they lead you to greater connection rather than greater clutter. I hope this ministry helps you to find meaning in the mess of our lives. And as you consider what you may offer, may these choices help you to prioritize what matters to you in your relationship to your family, your community and to God.



Annual Reports Are Due January 10! Committee Chairs, please submit your report on key actions by your committee in 2016, for our Annual Meeting which will be Feb. 12. This is Pat's and Leah's first year putting together the church's Annual Report, so please be prompt in your submissions. What is Per Capita?

Each year Presbyterian churches pay a certain amount of money to the higher governing bodies, calculated by the previous year's membership statistics. We are charged per member on our active member roll. This is a way of establishing a minimum level of support from the local churches for the salaries and administrative costs of the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly, and allows these governing bodies to plan their budget from year to year. This year we are being charged **\$40.00 per member**. **If you are a member of the church (and able), please pay your per capita apportionment using the blue envelope in the front of your 2017 envelope box or mark your check per capita.** You can put it in the offering plate or mail it to the church office.


Committee Membership

Committee members are not only welcome, but needed to do the vital work of the church. Please indicate which of these committees you would be willing to serve on. Experience is NOT required, merely an interest and a willing spirit. **Check boxes** where you would like to serve.

Asian Ministry –Develops outreach to our Asian neighbors and plans programs to foster appreciation and understanding between people of different cultures.

Budget & Finance – Recommends the annual church budget and, along

- with the Treasurer monitors income and disbursements throughout the year. Also responsible for long-range financial planning.
- **Christian Education** –Oversees the Sunday Church School and nursery; recruits and trains Church School teachers; recommends curriculum; helps provide for adult education. Help lay groundwork for a new youth group for teens and tweens at our church.
- Fellowship Plans social events, fellowship hours, and maintains the Sunday beverage cart.
- **Mission & Stewardship** –Plans and conducts programs for the financial stewardship (including special offerings) of the congregation, and interprets and promotes our mission locally and worldwide.
- **Membership & Outreach** –Evaluates our church's communication, both within the congregation and to the wider community. Proposes, plans and executes various efforts to welcome and incorporate new members.
- **Personnel** –Oversees the work of church employees, conducts annual performance reviews, and makes compensation recommendations to the session.
- **Property** –Oversees the regular maintenance of the church building and grounds; proposes and implements improvement projects.
- **Retreat** –Plans and implements one-day or overnight retreats of the congregation.
- **Worship** –Conceives and plans special services of worship, providing for services in the Pastor's absence and for routine tasks, such as communion preparation, reading of Scripture, ushering, and preparation of the sanctuary for worship and special services.
