## Sharing the Journey of Discipleship

Last month, JunHee Han shared a testimony from his faith journey. In it, he reflected on the disciple Thomas' doubt even as the resurrected Jesus stood right in front of him. JunHee shared some of his own stumbling blocks to faith. If we are honest, we all have questions that do not have answers; we have stories of when the church let us down; we have all seen Christians who do not behave the way Jesus taught us. We have been those people too!

These struggles are not new to the faith. The ESL Bible Study class is reading First Corinthians, a letter Paul wrote to one of the early churches in his missions. The church in Corinth had these same struggles too! But as Paul said, it is in a community of faith that we hold one another up. If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together" (1 Cor. 12:26).

We are already a church that does this well in the care we show for one another. I think we can also do it in the encouragement of faith. There is something about being part of a community of believers that makes this journey of following Jesus so much more worthwhile than trying to go it alone. Sure, sometimes we may annoy or disappoint one another. But if we believe the resurrected Jesus might appear beside us today, where better to look than to those who are also struggling to practice the faith, even if imperfectly?

I am so excited to journey together with you as we share the joys and challenges of faith. Please plan to come to my Service of Installation on May 7 at 3 pm, and take part in asking God's blessing on our ministry together.

### Japanese, Korean, & American sellers

Uganda has suffered severe trouble due to war and AIDS. Many children have lost parents and cannot attend school due to the cost, and many do not have things we consider basic in the United States, such as shoes.

The Presbyterian Church in Leonia is sponsoring a Japanese, Korean & American Garage Sale to raise funds for the Children of Uganda. The funds raised will be used for school materials, clothing, mosquito nets for the children, medicines, and much more. Representatives from our church have traveled to Uganda in summers past. They have had the joy of seeing how much a donation of ten or twenty dollars can do for orphans in Africa who don't have parents to buy things like socks and sweaters. They fit new shoes on children who had never worn shoes in their life. They watched as children danced around their mosquito nets, making up songs about how they would never get malaria again. They bought many different kinds of books to stock a new library.


