




<u>Presbyterian Church in Leonia</u> <u>Kitchen & Bathrooms Reservations Update for April 2019</u>

So what's taking so long? Why is the Women's Bathroom not available yet? It does seem as though our renovations have gotten a little bogged down. The work itself – building what needed to be built – has gone very well, but there are certain parts of the renovation still not finished.

We received the Women's Bathroom sink on the last Friday in March, about one month late. Rick Pumo, our construction manager, has had many explanations given to him, but the truth is that somehow that particular order got screwed up!

We all need to understand that particularly the kitchen will not be usable until we receive a certificate of occupancy (CO). We are using the all gender bathroom informally as it is not yet been inspected. Code officials for electrical, plumbing, fire safety, and health department will do inspections sequentially after each of those trades has completed all work for the trade, i.e all electrical, etc.

All appliances except the refrigerator have been purchased and installed. The committee is in the process now of identifying and purchasing the best refrigerator for the church. We are *nearly there*!


