

Over the past week, I have had several conversations with people about what makes for a worship experience on Sunday mornings. I have gained some interesting information! Of course, worship is not a "Your Way, Right Away" made-to-order event like a Burger King sandwich. There is some aspect of it being a communal experience, so a little give and take is involved knowing that if it does not speak to you, it may at least in some way speak to someone else-that is the hope! However, I have listened and gathered that many of us have absorbed the anxieties of the culture and politics. Some have said when they come to church, they seek a sanctuary from these things, or a moment of quiet away from the noise. Others have told me that they expect the church and the pastor to engage our faith with the social issues of the day. Know that I am listening to what you are telling me, and am trying very hard to craft a worshipful experience that touches each person who comes to our church seeking God.

One thing I am trying is to offer in the bulletin each week a Prayer Practice for the Home. This is a spiritual practice you can take home with you and try with your family; maybe it will give you strength to face the week and to incorporate the Holy Spirit's presence into your life.

Please know my door is open. I am eager and waiting to hear from you. And please pray for me. It is not easy finding a meaningful word that speaks to the whole congregation each week. I cannot do it alone, and I am also in prayer that God will guide me.



You will see that November 18 is Stewardship Sunday. Our theme for Stewardship this year is "Live Courageously." We will have people from the pews stand to give testimony to ways they have found courage in their lives. It takes courage to be generous, because when we give of ourselves or our resources, we are trusting them to people beyond our household, and to a time beyond this moment. It is an act of faith. It is taking courage for me to ask the congregation what they need in worship. I pray that courage will lead to generosity for how I share God's word with integrity.

Presbyterian Church in Leonia Kitchen & Bathrooms Renovations Newsletter Update for November 2018

The Kitchen & Bathrooms Renovations Committee has meeting regularly with our Contract Manager, Rick Pumo, to initiate the project. The contract between Rick Pumo and the church has been the first order of business. Upon completion he will begin two separate tasks: contracting with his subs and applying for required building permits. Rick estimates it will be 4 to 5 weeks prior to actual work beginning.

In planning the order of things to be done Rick Pumo recognized that the kitchen cabinets will take the longest time to fabricate. The committee made the decision to request that as much work as possible be completed as quickly as possible. This will result in working bathrooms being available weeks ahead of the installation of kitchen cabinets and availability of a working kitchen.

Each month we will keep the congregation updated on progress and stages of construction.

Total renovation costs were estimated at \$280,000. Kitchen & Bathrooms Renovation Fund Goal: \$100,000 to \$150,000. Total amount pledged to date toward construction costs is 67,630.


Weekly amounts proportionate to income are shown in the chart, or use the Commitment Planner to determine amount of gift based on percentage of income.
