Beware the Scam! Speak the Truth!

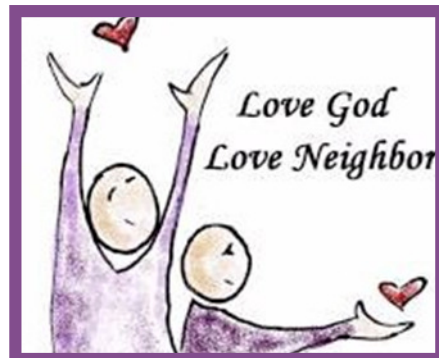
Over the holiday break, I kept getting urgent text messages from "CVS" saying that my daughter's prescription is ready in the pharmacy and to click on the link given in the text to confirm pickup. Except, my daughter had not been to the doctor and had been given no prescription. And, the text spelled her name off by one letter. Smells like a scam! In the past year or so I have had church members who have told me they have received text messages from "me" asking for gift cards or asking to click on a link. Except these were not from me! They were scams! I even got a call at the church and the caller ID gave the name of a church member, but it was a robocall offering financial services. This member is great at finance, but not quite so good at technology, so I was quite certain she would not be using robotic means to communicate with me. And, as tax season approaches, I always worry about people tricked by IRS scams (hint: the IRS will never call you- they will always communicate by mail!).

It is very hard in this day and age to know what is authentic. Apparently in Jesus' time, authenticity was a struggle as well. Jesus told his listeners, "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. You will know them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thorns, or figs from thistles?"

As Christians, my hope is that we will be known as ripe, authentic disciples because the fruits we show testify to the truths Jesus left us. "So, what are those fruits?" you may ask. I say that whatever models a pathway to better love our neighbor and better love God is a good fruit for Christians to show. Actually, those aren't my words—they are straight from the bible, and affirmed by Jesus himself.

As we flesh out this new year, let our message be authentic and our fruits be apparent. We love and serve Jesus Christ. We will show this by extending the pathways of love to God, and to our neighbor. That's no scam!
