

## All Saints' Day Communion Sunday

In the Presbyterian Church, we do not pray to saints, because we honor the "priesthood of ALL believers." That means that God calls each one of us to be saints. And so on All Saints' Day, we honor our calling as Christians to live holy and faithful lives, and also we honor those saints we love who have died before us. We do that this Sunday, November 3, when you will be invited to light candles and speak names in remembrance. We will also share in the sacrament of communion, and include prayers for the upcoming US election, for an outcome that leads to further peace and justice for ourselves and for the world.

Scriptures will be Ruth 1:1-18 and Mark 12:28-34. The sermon will be called "Today I Choose Love." We will have a Stewardship Testimony that will honor a special gift made by Diane Borer, in remembrance of her husband Elder Steve Borer.

We hold Sunday School for children and youth at 9:30 upstairs; Adult Bible Study at 9:30; and Activity Period for grades 4 and younger following the Children's Sermon.

As we prepare these remembrances, we hold fast to the truth that whether we live or we die, we belong to God.
