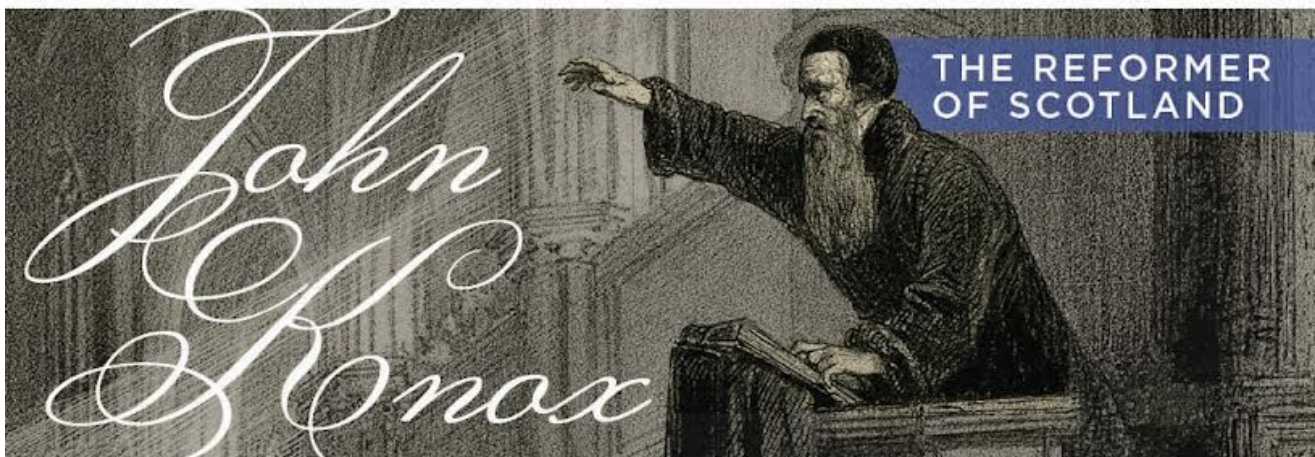

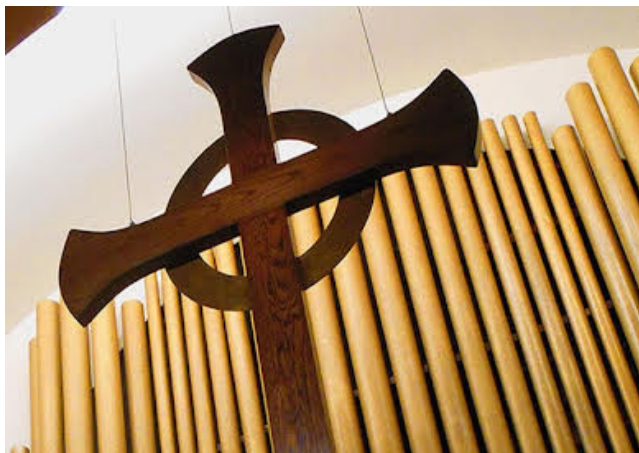
REFORMATION SUNDAY: OCTOBER 26
