NOTE: We would ask that people bring an appetizer, dessert, and/or bottle of wine to share.

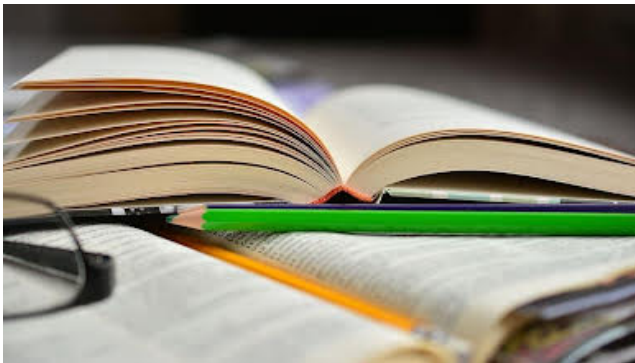
Here's how the evening will go:
